
CHARLES D. JONES ART SCHOLARSHIP

The SFA Friends of the Visual Arts Board (FVA) will award one \$1,000 scholarship per year in the name of Charles D. Jones to one SFA School of Art student to aid them in furthering their educational and professional goals in the field of art. Mr. Jones was a professor of art in printmaking at SFA for 41 years; during that time he was named a Regent's Professor and received the Distinguished Professor Alumni Award.

OBJECTIVES OF THE CHARLES JONES ART SCHOLARSHIP:

To support the educational goals of students currently enrolled in the SFA School of Art by providing financial assistance to outstanding students in the visual arts program at SFA.

To honor the legacy of Mr. Jones as a teacher and as an ardent supporter of the arts in this community as well as a huge supporter of the FVA Board.

CRITERIA FOR ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible to receive this scholarship, students must:

- be an undergraduate student with 60 hours toward an art degree, including hours in which they are currently enrolled.
- be a Junior, Senior, or Graduate Level student with drawing or printmaking as their major study area. First preference will be to Junior level students, then senior, then graduate level.
- must have taken beginning printmaking
- must have at least a C average
- must show initiative and a broad appreciation of the arts with a concentration on printmaking
- must show a willingness to explore both the technical demands as well as the expressive aspects of the medium.
- be current SFA students in Degree or Diploma courses within the SFA School of Art or graduate students in those Schools
- must be willing to donate a piece of art to at least one fundraising event sponsored by the FVA

PROCESS

SUBMISSION PROCEDURES

SFA Faculty must nominate a student by a letter of recommendation that will go to the FVA Scholarship committee for review and approval. The nomination should be discussed in a faculty meeting for approval by all faculty prior to submission of the letter to the FVA scholarship committee by March 15th.

DECISION PROCESS

After the SFA Art Faculty will reviews all nominations, they will make a recommendation to the FVA Scholarship committee. The FVA will announce the student who receives the award in at the Art Alliance spring show.

All monies provided through these grants will be awarded based on merit, correct completion of required documentation, and timely submission of requests.

The final decision for allocation of funds is solely at the discretion of the SFA Friends of the Visual Arts Scholarship Committee.
